Safety

The safety of students, staff, and parents is important to all of us and all of our jobs! Following are a few of the ways you can help:

- Anyone who is not a student or staff member must sign-in at the office, present their driver's license, and wear an identification badge. You may drop off items for students to pick up (lunch, water bottles, homework) in the front office.
- Students arriving after the tardy bell and leaving or returning before the end of the day must be signed in and out in the front office.
- If a family has special custody or security concerns, it is their responsibility to inform the school office in writing and provide copies of court orders that give or deny permission to specific parties.
- If a parent or community member is volunteering on a consistent schedule, they must complete a background check through Austin Partners in Education. The librarian can provide specific directions. Any parent driving on a field trip must have an additional background check.
- Dogs (other than properly identified service animals) are not permitted on campus. This is particularly important at pick up and drop off times.
- Do not use mobile communication devices (cell phones, etc.) while operating a motor vehicle in any school zone and through the pick up/drop off lines.
- Do not use the Homedale Drive parking lot as a drop-off or pick up location for students and park only in designated visitor parking spaces.
